



Code of Conduct – Parents / Guardians

All Parents / Guardians must meet the following requirements in regard to conduct during any activity sanctioned by HFI, a member association or an affiliated club event.

1. Do not abuse, harass or disrespect and Referee, Match official or ground official.
2. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others
3. Remember that your child participates in sport for their own enjoyment, not yours.
4. Focus on your child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
5. Never ridicule or yell at your child and other children for making a mistake or losing a competition.
6. Show appreciation for good performance and skilful plays by all players (including opposing players).
7. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with or in the vicinity of persons under 18 years of age.
8. Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise
9. Do not physically or verbally abuse or harass anyone associated with the sport (player, coach, umpire and so on).
10. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
11. Be a positive role model.

Any Parent or Guardian that does not comply with this Code of Conduct Policy or who otherwise causes a disturbance may be evicted from a venue and is subject to sanction under the HFI disciplinary and grievance regulations, which is available on the HFI website
